The people of Hebden Bridge and Mytholmroyd have demonstrated a fantastic level of support for the new kerbside recycling service – Kerbside (Calderdale). Through local support in money, time and publicity we have raised enough to begin operating earlier than planned.

For that reason Mytholmroyd and Hebden Bridge are the first to receive our new service from 22 March. This means collections from 5,000 households, 4 full-time jobs and 55 tonnes of rubbish per month diverted from landfill and recycled.

By April, we aim to have funding in place to expand to 25,000 households and create a fully operational training and work experience facility. This will benefit the long term unemployed and adults with learning difficulties, our prime reason for existing.

What has given me most pleasure is the teamwork ethic demonstrated by many organisations, businesses and individuals. We have demonstrated that a not-for-profit community organisation can provide an essential public service and work with the council and the private sector.

Nappy Laundry

Kerbside (Calderdale) is working together with other organisations in the district to reduce the amount of waste that we send to the dump.

Did you know? For every pound spent on disposable nappies, the taxpayer (YOU!) spend 10p getting rid of them! The UK throws away 8 million disposable nappies every single day!

The Change Project is Calderdale's very own nappy laundry service. We were set up to provide parents an informed choice and offer a viable alternative to disposables. We offer a weekly collection and laundry service throughout the district. For only £10 (£6) a week, we can provide you with up to 70 modern (no pins) cotton nappies as well as nappy liners, outer wraps and a storage bin. Simply place the used nappies in the bin, and leave it out on collection day – we will deliver a fresh supply of nappies and biodegradable liners when we collect. Please note that if the EcoBox is not presented correctly then our collectors have instructions not to empty it.
