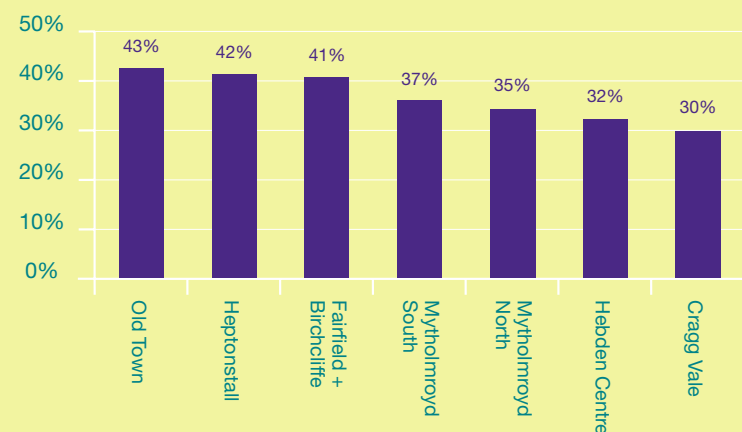

Thanks to everyone who has put their EcoBox out. As the weeks progressed more and more of you have participated in the scheme. **Congratulations to Old Town for achieving a 53%** participation rate in the last week of April. We've got off to a good start, but our objective is to reach an average rate of 60%.

We thought that Hebden Centre would have one of the highest participation rates, so only 1 in 3 households using their EcoBox was a disappointing surprise. *Is there anything we can do to make it easier for Hebden Centre residents to participate?*

Kerbside (Calderdale) is a Community Social Enterprise. Like a private company, a social enterprise aims to make a profit to support its sustainability. Whereas a private company's profits tend to go to boosting the wealth of individual shareholders, a social enterprise's profits go back into the organisation and the community to benefit the community. *So supporting us by recycling with us also supports your community.* We have many exciting ideas for our organisation and would welcome any ideas from you.

	EcoBox	✓	Yes Please	Place each bag in your EcoBox.
	Collection	✓	Yes Please	Place your EcoBox at the kerbside prior to 9 am on the collection day highlighted on the calendar on the back page.
	Excess Material	✗	No Thank You But...	We can only collect what is in the EcoBox, but you could ask a neighbour to use spare space in their EcoBox.
	Special Requests	✓	Yes Please	Contact us and we'll try to accommodate your request.

Please note that if your EcoBox is not presented correctly then our collectors have instructions not to empty it.

	Glass	✓	Yes Please	Bottles, jars (food & drink)
		✗	No Thank you	Broken glass, drinking glasses, window glass, pirex or light bulbs
	Cans	✓	Yes Please	Food & drinks cans, aluminium & steel
		✗	No Thank you	Dirty food cans
	Textiles	✓	Yes Please	All re-usable clothing-please tie plastic bag
		✗	No Thank you	Carpets or rugs
	Shoes	✓	Yes Please	Please tie these together and place in tied plastic bag
		✗	No Thank you	Odd shoes
