**Thank you** to everyone who has put out their EcoBox and **welcome to the additional 9000 homes** that are just beginning to receive the collection service.

Our staff of 6 will soon be 9. Four of the current staff were unemployed, but began as volunteers, so if you are struggling to find work why not try volunteering with us?

We have 2 trainees gaining work experience and we'll be working hard in 2005 to create many more opportunities.

We are paid by the tonne, so please use your EcoBox and help the environment and people in Calderdale. **Your participation makes a real difference.**

**We will be collecting as normal over the Christmas period – Wishing you a happy Christmas from all of us at Kerbside (Calderdale)**

Some food for thought:

- Each of you produces more than **half a tonne** of waste per year, a total of 100,000 tonnes for Calderdale.
- This has to be buried, but 1/3 of that waste has a value of £40 per tonne when recycled – **so £1.2 million pounds of your money is buried each year!**
- Then the people of Calderdale pay £30 per tonne in landfill tax to bury it – **that is another £900,000.**

**Now that's what we call waste. So recycle and save your money!**

do's and don'ts do's and	Separation	✓	Yes Please	Place each material into a separate bag i.e. a bag for paper, a bag for textiles, a bag for tin cans, a bag for each coloured glass (green, clear and brown).
	EcoBox	✓	Yes Please	Place each bag in your EcoBox.
	Collection	✓	Yes Please	Place your EcoBox at the kerbside prior to 9 am on the collection day highlighted on the calendar on the back page.
	Excess Material	✗	No Thank You But...	We can only collect what is in the EcoBox, but you could ask a neighbour to use spare space in their EcoBox.
	Special Requests	✓	Yes Please	Contact us and we'll try to accommodate your request.

Please place each material in tied plastic bags – cans in one bag, glass in another, etc. Please note that if your EcoBox is not presented correctly then our collectors have instructions not to empty it

	Glass	✓	Yes Please	Bottles, jars (food & drink)
		✗	No Thank you	Broken glass, drinking glasses, window glass, pirex or light bulbs
	Cans	✓	Yes Please	Food & drinks cans, aluminium & steel
		✗	No Thank you	Dirty food cans, other metal items
	Textiles	✓	Yes Please	All re-usable clothing-please tie plastic bag
		✗	No Thank you	Carpets or rugs
	Shoes	✓	Yes Please	Please tie these together and place in tied plastic bag
		✗	No Thank you	Odd shoes
