Each year the tax on burying waste increases by £3 per tonne. The Tax is currently £30 per tonne and Calderdale householders create 100,000 tonnes of waste per year. That tax bill is paid via your council tax.

Calderdale has 2,500 job seekers and 10,000 people on incapacity benefit. Many of those people want to work, but our society makes it difficult for them.

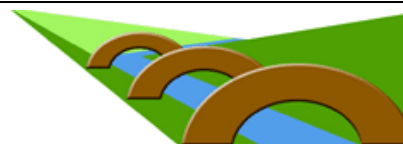

Both parents, Betsy and Floozy (pictured) are doing well and are absolutely delighted.

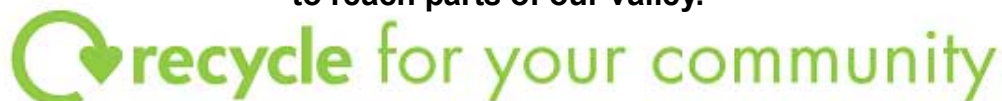
