## YOU ARE RECYCLING STARS

Welcome to the 750 additional households who have started recycling with us in the last three months. 48% of households in the Upper Calder Valley are now using the recycling service provided by Kerbside. The Upper Calder Valley is streets ahead of the rest of Calderdale when it comes to recycling.

## RECYCLE YOUR BATTERIES

We are now collecting household (NOT car) batteries. Special bags are being delivered to all households for storing batteries for collection in your EcoBox. Calderdale is fortunate to have this service, having been successful in bidding to deliver a trial for WRAP (the Waste & Resources Action Programme).

**Our project for CARE, PROGRESSION and SELF-WORTH for those with a learning disability**

Kerbside's care for those with a learning disability is provided in a working environment where everyone is part of the team serving the people of Calderdale.

In this environment trainees learn independence skills such as washing, drying and ironing clothes for sale on our Wednesday market stall in Hebden Bridge. They also use our online shop to learn IT skills ([www.spiralbridge.co.uk/washandgrow](http://www.spiralbridge.co.uk/washandgrow)) along with social and financial skills on the market stall. Our workforce appreciates their presence in our team and the trainees gain in self-worth, confidence and skills.

The Mayor of Hebden Royd, Stewart Brown, visited our market stall and met with our Training Coordinator Fran and our valuable volunteers Asad and Ian.

The Mayor commented "This is a local initiative that is really making a difference. The recycling of clothes removes material from landfill sites and the stall helps sustain the market in Hebden Bridge, whilst promoting recycling. In addition Kerbside (Calderdale) is providing valuable training and work experience opportunities for individuals."

<b>What to do</b>	<b>Separation</b>	✓	Put each material into a separate tied bag - i.e. a bag for paper, a bag for textiles, a bag for tin cans, a bag for each different colour of glass (green, clear and brown)
	<b>EcoBox</b>	✓	Put each bag in your EcoBox
	<b>Collection</b>	✓	Place your EcoBox at the kerbside prior to 9am on the collection day highlighted on the calendar on the back page
	<b>Excess material</b>	✓	Please place beside your box
	<b>Special requests</b>	✓	Contact us and we'll try to accommodate your request

### Materials

<b>Dos and Dont's</b>	<b>Paper</b>	✓	Newspapers, magazines, phone directories, catalogues, junk mail, flattened cereal/pizza boxes
		X	Cardboard, egg boxes
	<b>Glass</b>	✓	Bottles, jars (food and drink)
		X	Broken glass, drinking glasses, window glass, pyrex or light bulbs
	<b>Cans</b>	✓	Food and drinks cans, aluminium and steel. Please wash all cans
		X	Dirty food cans, other metal items
	<b>Textiles</b>	✓	All re-usable clothing, curtains and towels
		X	Carpets, rugs or duvets
	<b>Shoes</b>	✓	Please tie pairs of shoes together
		X	Odd shoes
	<b>Household batteries</b>	✓	Household batteries can be placed in the special collection bag or carrier bag then placed in your EcoBox
		X	Car batteries

Please note that if your EcoBox is not presented correctly then our collectors have instructions not to empty it.

## Recycling for Business

You recycle at home with us, now you can start recycling at work. We are now providing a recycling service to small and medium sized businesses in Calderdale. We can collect from your workplace or you can deliver materials to us.

As more people recycle at home it is time to look at what is happening to the waste you produce at work. Our recycling service is easy and convenient and will help your business do its bit to protect the environment. We can arrange regular collections and will provide you with collection boxes or sacks. We can recycle paper, cardboard, glass, drink and food cans and printer cartridges.

By signing up to our recycling service your business will also receive promotional posters to help set up the scheme, certificates to show your customers that you are recycling and an audit trail of materials and amounts recycled.

There is a small charge for using our collection service, but you can deliver materials to us free of charge.
